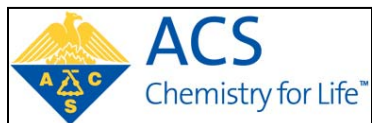


ACS SUMMER SCHOOL ON GREEN

Program Description: The Summer School will explore scientific solutions to global challenges, with a special emphasis on sustainable energy. Participants will engage in a number of activities designed to provide a solid foundation in green chemistry and sustainable energy: presentations by leading researchers and educators, collaborative problem solving projects, student presentations, and discussions on the role of science and technology in solving global sustainability challenges.

Please note that English is the official language of the Summer School.

Eligibility: The Summer School is open to graduate students and postdoctoral scholars studying in the Americas. Applicants should be interested in developing collegial relationships that will result in future collaborations.

Application Procedure: Applicants must send to gceducation@acs.org by **March 14, 2011** the electronic application form (available online at the URL above) along with the following materials:

- A curriculum vitae (CV) or résumé
- Unofficial Transcript of Graduate Courses
- Letter of nomination from the applicant's faculty advisor or another faculty member
- One-page essay by the applicant concerning his/her interest in green chemistry and sustainable energy, including any previous experience with the field and how he/she will benefit from participation in the Summer School.

Deadline for receipt of applications is **March 14, 2011**.
